

Home Safety

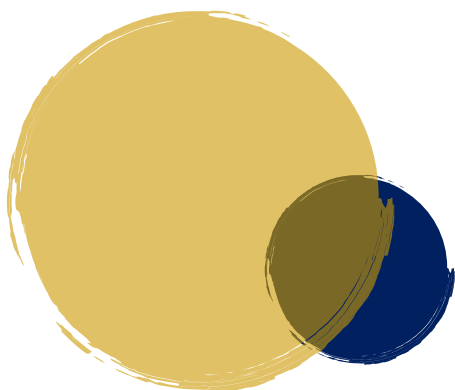

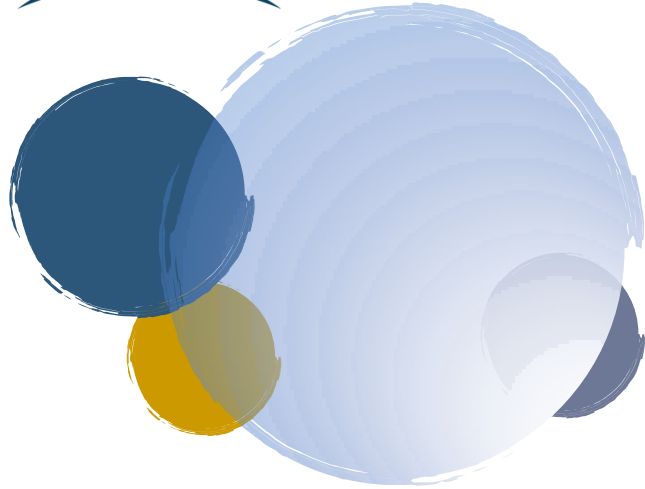

Mission

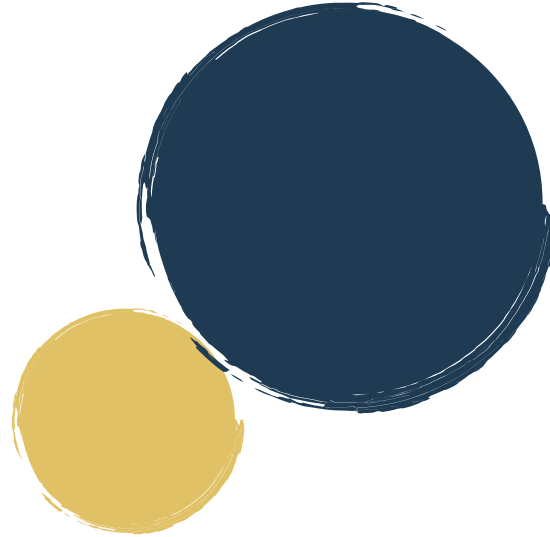
